- Worked with Congressman Tim Burchett to contact DOE about fixing retiree pension and healthcare plan inequities.
- Monitored activities on DOE contractor Request for Proposals (RFPs) at ETTP and Y-12.

- Filed formal comments recommending revision to the content about retiree benefits management in the Y-12 RFP.
